This is the same camp we attended last year and I expect the Student Life Missions camp this summer to be no different.

The Camp Speaker for the week is going to be a man by the name of Timothy Ateek. He is a talented speaker that speaks all over the world. I am excited to see how the Lord will use him during the Student Life Week. Accompanied with Timothy will be the Jared Wood band to lead us into the presence of the Lord through worship all week!

### **How and Where Student Life works**

What is unique about the Student Life Organization is the way they operate. Student Life conferences are hosted on College campuses all around the U.S.A. This gives them the freedom to bring this conference virtually anywhere. This year we will be attending Student Life at Louisiana Tech. The University is about 5 hours east of Houston and will hold about 1200 students from all over the country during that week. One of the perks to having this conference on a college campus is that we will have access to most of the recreational activities the college has to offer. When we have free time during the week we will be able to participate in activities such as:

### **What it is going to cost?**

Student Life is a little expensive but totally worth it. So what we are trying to do is install payment plans and fundraisers to help lessen the blow. The price per Student will be \$395.00 + the cost of a meal there and back. The Cost includes: Housing, Food for the week (13 meals), and the use of the Universities recreational facilities, missions supplies and a professional band and Speaker. **A \$100.00 deposit and all forms are due by January 25<sup>th</sup>. Paying the deposit will reserve and guarantee your spot. After the 25th we cannot promise you an open spot. We are working on a first come first serve basis.**

## **What do I Need to Bring?**

Well this depends on who you are, but for most your list should look something like this:
